RIESLING 2021

Fresh Citrus and floral notes

TASTING NOTES

Fresh citrus and floral notes dominate the nose of this wine. It shows bright grapefruit characters with some apple notes that fills the aroma. Spice with some litchee fruit characters fill the palate. The wine is well-balanced with a ripe palate that lingers on to a long and dry finish. This Riesling displays excellent fruit purity together with fine texture and mouth-watering acidity finishes linear and persistent. This wine is very approachable now however it will reward cellaring for the next 10 years.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

At the start of the growing season, we had several frost events affecting isolated areas in Marlborough. During flowering there was a cold spell of weather, which had a significant effect on the region's fruit set. While this affects the yield, it can help promote concentration of aromas and flavors in the grapes. Mild summer conditions help with even ripening of the grapes which allowed perfect conditions to pick at optimum ripeness.

VINIFICATION

The fruit for this wine was sourced from a single vineyard in the Rapaura area of Marlborough, famed for its alluvial soils. The grapes were machine harvested and gently pressed with only the free run portion being used in the wine. The juice underwent fermentation in stainless steel tank.
